


LICENCING EXPLAINED 2016

- The current membership and licencing scheme is managed online by Cycling NZ <http://www.cyclingnewzealand.nz/>
- Membership runs annually from 1 January to 31 December and is usually available for the following year from 1 November (to permit competition over the holiday period)
- If you are a new member then click Join CyclingNZ.

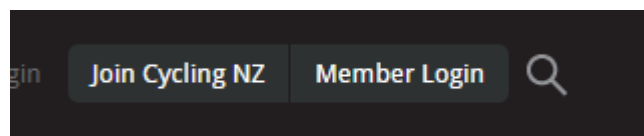

Enter your email address and password. If you have forgotten your password then click Forgot Password and a new one will be emailed to you.

Note: CyclingNZ's new website will make you have a new password : " Our new system cannot migrate passwords for privacy reasons, so if you're renewing your licence the first thing you'll need to do is reset your password. If you have any difficulties please email membership@cyclingnewzealand.nz and we'll be able to help."

- In a family, each person MUST have a unique email address. Use Gmail, etc. to set up an email account for each family member.

- Membership encompasses Pegasus Club Fees, Canterbury Centre Rider Fees and CyclingNZ fees as a “one stop shop”. These fees are (for a national level licence): \$100/\$20/\$30 respectively.
- Keep your password handy for upgrades and renewals.

The prices shown on this page are the national fees only and don’t contain centre and club fees.
- Remember that when renewing the system will offer you automatically the same membership as that currently held or recently expired. Carefully check that this is what you want and that personal information and contact details are up to date before accepting and proceeding to checkout. Also remember that if the new licence means you have moved up to an older age category you may no longer compete at the younger age group even though there may be some time left whilst your old licence is still valid.

Note that for cycle racing you can be ‘local’ or ‘national’.

In Canterbury the ‘**local**’ licence will allow you to take part in any competition within the Canterbury region run by any Canterbury club. This included Centre events. The ‘local’ licence incorporates a ‘centre’ fee.

To take part in National events run ‘out of Centre’ by other CyclingNZ centres you will need to buy a ‘National’ level licence.

Fun events and other non CyclingNZ cycling events will have their own rules.
